

Please note – Works for Mill Lane have been extended.

Works will be carried out with estimated completion by 14th March 2025.

Please note – The below works have been postponed for Eythorne Road & Mill Lane, Shepherdswell.

Phase 1 – Eythorne Road will be closed from 2nd September 2024, with estimated completion by 6th December 2024.

Phase 2 – Mill Lane will be closed from 6th January 2025, with estimated completion by 28th February 2025.

Please note – The below works have been postponed for Eythorne Road & Mill Lane, Shepherdswell.

Phase 1 – Eythorne Road will be closed from 17th June 2024, with estimated completion by 20th September 2024.

Phase 2 – Mill Lane will be closed from 14th October 2024, with estimated completion by 6th December 2024.

SGN - Temporary Road Closure - Eythorne Road & Mill Lane, Shepherdswell - 13th May 2024 (Dover District)

Due to works planned to be undertaken by **SGN**, it will be necessary to close part of Eythorne Road & Mill Lane, Shepherdswell, in 2 phases as detailed below.

Phase 1 - Eythorne Road will be closed from 13th May 2024, with estimated completion by 16th August 2024. The road will be closed between the junctions of Station Road and The Glen, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Eythorne Road, Coxhill, A2 Dover Road, Coldred Hill, Church Road, Coldred Road, Sandwich Road, Wigmore Lane, Shepherdswell Road and vice versa.

Phase 2 - Mill Lane will be closed from 2nd September 2024, with estimated completion by 25th October 2024. The road will be closed from number 2 to number 36, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Mill Lane, Great Haynes, Eythorne Road, Church Hill and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing gas works to be carried out, works are undertaken by SGN.
